ends with <b>consonant + y</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>change <b>y</b> to <b>i + es</b></li> <li>( family → families )</li> </ul>	Man - Men
ends with <b>consonant + o</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>add <b>es</b></li> <li>( potato → potatoes )</li> </ul>	Mouse - Mice
ends in <b>f or fe</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>change <b>f</b> to <b>v</b></li> <li>add <b>es</b></li> <li>( knife → knives )</li> </ul>

	Verb
I, You, We, They	get, study, watch, go
He, She, It	verb + <b>s</b> = gets
	consonant + <b>y</b> = <b>ies</b> fly = <b>flies</b> study = <b>studies</b>
	End in: s, ss, x, ch, sh, o, z = <b>es</b> watch → <b>watches</b>

### Negative

Verb to be	+	Negative	+	verb	=	Simple present sentences
I, You, We, They	+	don't	+	play	=	<i>I don't play</i> <i>You don't play</i> <i>We don't play</i> <i>They don't play</i>
He, She, It	+	doesn't	+	play	=	<i>He doesn't play</i> <i>She doesn't play</i> <i>It doesn't play</i>
